

## Crest of the Wave Lace Scarf

This lovely lace scarf is named after its main pattern stitch "Crest of the Wave"—a derivative of the popular Shetland lace stitch Feather and Fan or Old Shale. The main stitch area of graceful lacy waves is surrounded by a knit-as-you-go elegant ribbed openwork border.

### Yarn and Needles

500 yards of laceweight or fingering yarn, approximately 2 to 3 oz for blocked measurements of 14" by 68"

Size 6 US (4.0 mm) needles

Gauge: Average of 4½ stitches per inch over combination of border and main patterns after blocking under tension
